

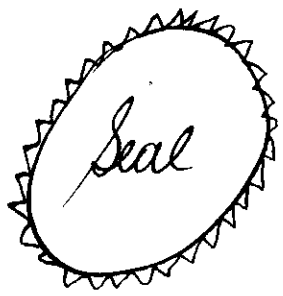
# Internal Improvement Fund—State of Florida. 168

Deed No. 8506






Know all Men by these Presents, That the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund, under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Florida, entitled "An Act to Provide for and Encourage a Liberal System of Internal Improvements in this State," approved January 6, 1855, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar per acre, to them in hand paid by Jesse J. Knight of the county of Manatee, State of Florida, have granted, bargained and sold, and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Jesse J. Knight and his heirs and assigns, forever, the following described **LANDS**, to-wit:

The North West quarter  
of the North West quarter  
of Section Five  
in Township Thirty-nine South  
of Range Nineteen East.

containing Thirty-nine and  $\frac{25}{100}$  acres, and lying and being in the county of Manatee, in said State of Florida:  
**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** unto the said Jesse J. Knight and his heirs and assigns, forever, in fee simple.



In Testimony Whereof, a majority of said Trustees have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals, and have caused an impression of the seal of "THE FLORIDA STATE LAND OFFICE" to be made hereupon, at the Capitol, in the City of Tallahassee, on this, the sixth day of May, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.
